

HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

Attendance

Students will:

- attend regularly and arrive at school by 8.40am every day

Parents will:

- Ensure their child attends school every day by 8.40am.
- Inform school at the earliest opportunity where their child cannot attend.

School will:

- inform parents as soon as possible if their child is absent without an explanation from home
- recognise and reward good attendance

Behaviour and discipline – students learn best in an orderly environment where everybody knows what is expected of them

Parents will:

- give praise at home for good behaviour at school
- work with the school to find solutions in cases of unacceptable behaviour
- ensure students wear full school uniform and adhere to all school policies

Students will:

- behave in a respectful manner at all times
- Wear the school uniform appropriately

School will:

- implement a behaviour policy which creates a safe and respectful environment for everyone
- ensure that all staff, students and parents understand the school's expectations

Homework – learning at home has an important part to play in helping students to achieve.

Parents will:

- support independent learning at home
- encourage their child to read regularly
- make sure that materials borrowed from school are returned

Students will:

- complete homework on time
- read regularly and return books to school

School will:

- set and mark homework as appropriate
- keep parents informed about homework through SMHW
- provide suitable materials and advice on homework and how to help with reading

Communication – good communication between home and school is essential to make sure that students get the support they need.

Parents will:

- inform school on any matters which might affect their child's work or behaviour
- talk with teachers on parents' evenings or at other times about their child's progress
- raise concerns directly and promptly with school

Students will:

- take home letters, notes and reports from school and give them to parents or carers
- talk with parents or carers and teachers about any worries in school

School will:

- ensure that parents have information about their child's progress and behaviour
- arrange for parents to discuss their child's progress
- ensure that we listen and act on parental concerns
