

SNHS Home-School Agreement 2022-23

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

Parents / Carers will:

- Take reasonable action to ensure that their child / children attends school on time daily.
- Immediately inform school of any issues affecting attendance, including illness or other personal issues.

Students will:

- Attend daily and arrive on time.

School will:

- Inform parents as soon as possible if their child is absent without an explanation.
- Recognise and reward good attendance.
- Support and challenge where absence is becoming a cause for concern.

BEHAVIOUR AND ATTITUDE TO LEARNING (AToL)

Parents / Carers will:

- Reward good behaviour at school.
- Work with the school to find solutions in cases of poor choices.
- Ensure wearing of full school uniform and support rules around appearance (piercings / hair colour for example)

Students will:

- Follow the school rules and accept consequences for poor choices.
- Wear the school uniform and follow the rules on appearance.

School will:

- Apply proportionate consequences for poor choices and reward good choices through the merit system.
- Ensure that expectations are clearly set out and understood.

HOMEWORK / INDEPENDENT STUDY AND REVISION

Parents / Carers will:

- Check their child's homework using the relevant app.
- Provide a quiet place for homework and ensure it is completed.
- Encourage their child to read regularly.

Students will:

- Complete homework to the best their ability and hand in on time.

School will:

- Follow the homework setting policy and check that homework has been completed.
- Provide suitable materials and advice on homework.

COMMUNICATION

Parents / Carers will:

- Tell school about anything which might affect their child's work or behaviour.
- Discuss their child's progress at Parents' Evening.
- Always respect school staff in communication and dialogue, avoid any unreasonable behaviour or attitude (including abusive or demanding attitudes).

Students will:

- Pass on communication from school to home.
- Share with staff, any concerns about their wellbeing.

School will:

- Make sure that parents have information about their child's progress and behaviour.
- Share extra-curricular information about trips visits, clubs and events.
- Arrange for parents to discuss their child's progress and to set targets for the future.
