The successful candidate will have the ability to teach Biology, Chemistry or Physics up to KS4, across the ability spectrum. The successful candidate will preferably have the ability to teach two sciences to GCSE level. Suitable candidates requesting an earlier start would be considered.

First and foremost, we require a teacher who can build excellent relationships with students. We are also seeking to appoint somebody with a good sense of humour and who enjoys working in a team. These are hugely important qualities in terms of collaborative working, but also in getting the very best out of our students.

Subject knowledge is important, as is an up-to-date knowledge of the latest developments in Science. The successful candidate will thoroughly enjoy teaching their subject and understand the importance of Science in contributing to our students' wider development.

In return, we offer a first-class learning environment, working with students who are typically above national average attainment at start point in Year 7. Our Science department is strong with specialist Science teachers across all subjects.

The staff body is very experienced and we have a highly committed team who always 'go the extra mile' for the school and community. All staff are expected to contribute to the development of new resources and to work collaboratively with others. We also offer excellent professional development opportunities and a wide range of facilities.

The school was inspected in 2019 and remains 'Good' following a Section 8 Ofsted Inspection. We consider many aspects of our provision to be excellent and we are now working to securing even further improvements at the school.
